- I will arrive on time and be reliable for my volunteer assignment.

- I will dress appropriately for my volunteer assignment and will act in a professional manner at all times toward staff and volunteers, families and participants.
- I agree to respect and maintain confidentiality of all privileged information related to New England Disabled Sports and its' participants.
- I will share with the NEDS staff any concerns that I may have related to participant welfare and/or safety.
- I will contact the New England Disabled Sports staff if I am unable to attend my scheduled volunteer time. I will do so as early as possible.
- I understand that if my time commitment as a New England Disabled Sports volunteer instructor is not being met that my season pass may be revoked.
- Whenever possible I will abide by the "three person rule." I understand that whenever possible a participant is not to be left alone with an employee or volunteer unless a 3rd party present.
- I will not disclose, use or disseminate participant photographs or personal information regarding participants to anyone.
- I understand that it is prohibited to report to my volunteer shift unfit or using, possessing, distributing or being under the influence of illegal drugs, alcohol or prescription drugs.
- I agree not to smoke on the grounds of any NEDS, Loon Mountain or Bretton Woods properties.
- I will abide by all New England Disabled Sports policies and procedures.
- I will report all near misses, incidents and/or accidents to the New England Disabled Sports staff immediately.

I will not have contact with participants outside of lesson times without the knowledge and/or consent of
